The members of the AA Potter Chapter of the Indiana Society of Professional Engineers (ISPE) are pleased to see that two licensed professionals are competing for the Republican Party nomination for Tippecanoe County Surveyor. Licensed surveyors and engineers have as their primary obligation the protection of the safety, health and welfare of the public in the performance of their professional duties. In addition, these licensed professionals agree to perform assignments only when qualified by education or experience in the specific technical field of the profession involved. Registered professional engineers and land surveyors are required to complete approved, continuing education courses every two years to maintain their active license.

In order to help voters make an informed decision, the members of the AA Potter Chapter of ISPE encourage both candidates to share their record of continuing education with the public. Additional information about the rules governing the professions of engineering and land surveying can be found in sections 864 and 865 of the Indiana Administrative Code. The duties of the county surveyor are described in Indiana Code, Title 36, Article 2, Chapter 12.
